This instructor-led training course introduces the student to the HP StorageWorks Modular Smart Array (MSA) 2012fc, 2012i, 2312fc, and 2324fc. This course focuses on implementing and managing an MSA SAN solution. The student gains an understanding of the features, benefits, and components of each of the systems and learns the main considerations for installing, configuring, and troubleshooting the systems. The student also learns to use the various tools and utilities available for configuring and managing the array systems. The classroom instruction is augmented by a number of lab exercises that correlate with the lecture materials.
