This course is taught at the BCM50 Release 3.0 BCM200/400 Release 4.0 and BCM450 Rls. 1.0 level. Note: BCM50 hardware installation content and messaging content is not included in this course. Course 6045C/X/T/W BCM50 Release 3.0 Installation Initial Configuration and Messaging is a prerequisite to this course. Course 6045C/X/T/W instructs you on how to install the BCM50 hardware perform initial configuration and configure messaging on your BCM50.
