

# HP-UX Troubleshooting

## Overview

This course examines some of the problems that can negatively impact productivity in HP-UX system and network operations. It presents some of the tools and procedures that can be used to find the causes of problems and fix them. The 5-day course is 55 percent lecture and 45 percent hands-on labs using cell-based HP Integrity servers.

## Pre-Requisites

- ✓ HP-UX System and Network Administration I (H3064S) and HP-UX System and Network Administration II (H3065S) or
- ✓ HP-UX System and Network Administration for Experienced UNIX® System Administrators (H5875S)

Or equivalent experience.

- ✓ The course includes nPar and vPar troubleshooting, so attendance of HP-UX Partition Management (U5075S or HG770S) is recommended.

## Objectives

- ✓ Use the Management Processor for troubleshooting.
- ✓ Recover a non-bootable HP Integrity system or partition.
- ✓ Work through file system recovery options.
- ✓ Troubleshoot a kernel crash dump.
- ✓ Troubleshoot patch problems.
- ✓ Troubleshoot network, NFS, and DNS problems.
- ✓ Troubleshoot EFI problems.
- ✓ Recover a non-bootable HP 9000 system or partition.
- ✓ Troubleshoot an 11i v3 kernel.
- ✓ Troubleshoot process problems.
- ✓ Troubleshoot storage problems.
